## 2. BYOD – the Bring-Your-Own-Device principle


Depending on the examination centre, you can also take the exam on your own computer. However, this also means that you are responsible for making sure that your computer works properly.

## 3. Minimum technical requirements and our recommendations

For Windows devices, you can typically find the system information under SETTINGS ▶ SYSTEM ▶ INFO.

### Your device **must** meet the following requirements:

- Screen size at least 13 inches – **we recommend 15 inches**
- **Laptop only**, no tablet, no desktop PC
- Operating system at least Windows 10
- At least 1 GB of RAM (RAM)
- At least 512 MB of free space



### You **must** also bring the following with you:

- Power cable/Charging cable
- Headphones

### You **can** also bring the following with you:

- Mouse
- Keyboard

**All devices are only permitted with a cable.** Headphones, mouse and keyboard with Bluetooth or wireless connections are not permitted. The image on the left shows the ideal setup.



## 4. SEB – the Safe Exam Browser

In order to take the exam, you must install the Safe Exam Browser before the exam, the instructions can be found here <https://app.osd.at/seb-download>

**Important note:** If the Safe Exam Browser is not installed at the beginning of the exam, you will not be able to take the exam!
